Glass Double Bottle

DRY RIESLING, Chateau Ste. Michelle (Columbia Valley, WA)

7.75 15.00 30.00

Dry style Riesling, with aromas of citrus, melon and peach, coupled with crisp green apple notes. Finely balanced with a crisp dry finish.

PINOT GRIGIO, St. Michael-Eppan (Italy)

8.25 16.00 32.00

Aroma is rich in fruits especially pears; dry and smooth on palate, leaves a long pleasant aftertaste.

SAUVIGNON BLANC, Babich (Marlborough, New Zealand)

8.25 16.00 32.00

Lively bouquet combining herbal and fennel aromas with gooseberry and bell pepper. Palate is sweet fruited and rich, with a lingering yet crisp finish.

CHARDONNAY, William Hill (Central Coast, CA)

8.25 16.00 32.00

Aromas of vanilla, honeysuckle, peach and pear; full bodied, rich with refined acidity aged in American and French Oak.

CHARDONNAY, Louis Latour, Ardeche (France)

Made in southern France, very dry, with a lingering, smooth finish.

MALBEC, Tinto Negro (Mendoza, Argentina)

8.25 16.00 32.00

A rich and round textured Malbec with loads of chocolate, dried berry and hints of vanilla character. Full and flavorful.

PINOT NOIR, Böen (Central Coast, CA)

8.75 17.00 34.00

57% Santa Barbara, 29% Monterey and 14% Sonoma county-grown fruit all contribute to this Pinot's rich berry flavors, baking spice notes, and an enveloping mouthfeel.

MERLOT, Oberon (Napa Valley, CA)

8.75 17.00 34.00

Layers of lush black cherry and raspberry flavors complemented by oak barrel aging and a velvety texture, hallmark of Napa Valley Merlot.

RED BLEND, Caparzo (Italy)

7.50 14.50 29.00

85% Sangiovese, 5% Merlot, 5% Petit Verdot, 5% Alicante. A bright & fruity red with sliced dark cherries & lemons. Full body, lovely fruit and a clean, fresh finish; a fun and flavorful Sangiovese.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON, Storypoint Vineyards (Sonoma County, CA)

8.75 17.00 34.00

Rich and intense, this highly aromatic Cabernet features subtle spice Characters, layers of dark fruit flavors and toffee notes. Grapes were cold soaked to capture intense color, then fermented separately before blending and aging on French oak.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON, Jordan (Alexander Valley, Sonoma County)

Concentrated aromas of blackberries and black cherries with an Inviting hint of cedar, aged one year in French oak barrels.
